 - 4.0 Grade 4-5 and Kindergarten transitions:

 - 4.1 Staff:

 - 4.2 School Goals:

 - 5.1 Questions and concerns that were brought up:
 - 5.1.1. What will happen with grade 2 swim lessons? Unfortunately this year's grade 2 students will just miss them completely. They will not be made up at another date.
